OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant seeks authority to discontinue public utility warehouse operations in Fresno. These operations are confined to the storage of bulk grain. Authority is sought to cancel its tariff on file with the Commission.

The application states that for the past several years applicant's business has been of a nonpublic utility nature, and that there have been no patrons using its public utility warehouse facilities.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought authority to discontinue service should be granted. Applicant's tariff will be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Grover B. Hill Company, a corporation, dba Fresno Grain Warehouse Co., be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman, and that Fresno Grain Warehouse Company tariff, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
