## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 52393 herein was issued December 20, 1955. It provided that a certificate of public convenience and necessity therein defined should be issued to applicant upon filing an analysis of its insurance obligations and upon certain corrections in its accounting practices.

On February 14, 1956 applicant filed a verified statement with the Commission which indicates substantial compliance with these requirements.

Applicant having filed a verified statement in compliance with the condition set forth in ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 52393 herein, and good cause appearing; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

That the conditional grant of a certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicant set forth in Decision No. 52393, dated December 20, 1955 herein, is hereby made unconditional.
