OPINION

Rose J. Antonini, Louis E. Antonini and Virgil J. Antonini are engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.

Applicants seek an order authorizing them to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables and nuts, generally between all; points in San Joaquin County and a 30-mile radius of Hood and Stockton and San Francisco-Oakland Bay points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order. It appears that applicants possess the experience, equipment, personnel and financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

Applicants are hereby placed upon notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be

- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicants shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.
- (3) The operative right "for the transportation of fruits, vegetables and nuts in boxes, crates and sacks, between Stockton and San Francisco and Oakland" granted by Decision No. 25944, dated May 10, 1933, in Application No. 18720, is cancelled simultaneously with the filings made pursuant to and required by the provisions of paragraph (2) hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.

Antonini, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision, are authorized to transport edible nuts as listed under that heading in Items

Nos. 33530 through 33602 of Western Classification No. 75,

Cal. P.U.C. No. 8, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof and Supplements Nos. 27, 41, 46 and 47 thereto; :

fruits, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen); and vegetables, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen), including fresh mushrooms, between Stockton and points within a radius of 30 miles thereof, on the one hand, and Oakland and San Francisco, on the other hand. Such authority does not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.
