O P I N I O N

Hodgson-Matteson Company, a corporation, is a highway carrier engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued it by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of livestock, hay and grain between all points and places in California, and of steel, between Eureka on the one hand and South San Francisco and Fontana on the other hand.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice it appears that public convenience and necessity do not require that this application be granted.

It also appears that applicant does not possess the financial resources to institute and maintain the proposed operation. The application will be denied. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 36240 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
