SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates for the transportation of asphaltic concrete and related items in dump truck equipment within Los Angeles and Orange counties are set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7. Zone rates are provided for movements between designated production areas and delivery zones. Mileage rates and hourly rates apply between points not covered by zone rates. The mileage and hourly rates are generally higher than the zone rates.

By Petition for Modification No. 21 in this proceeding, California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks extension of the zone rate system to cover deliveries of asphaltic concrete from Production Area "P" in Los Angeles County to delivery zones in Orange County.

Petitioner represents that considerable quantities of material are being delivered from this production facility to points in Orange County, much of which is being transported by for-hire dump trucks. It shows that competitive production areas now enjoy zone rates to these points. Petitioner asserts that the establishment of the proposed zone rates would be of benefit to carriers, shippers and the general public.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection to its being granted has been received.

Upon consideration the Commission concludes and finds as a fact that the zone rates hereinafter provided are reasonable and suitable minimum rates for the transportation in question. The petition will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.


Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7




This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.


