O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an extension to existing spur track at a continuation of the spur track grade in and along Bancroft Avenue, between Third and Mendell Streets, in the City and County of San Francisco, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

The proposed spur track extension will be constructed in an area between the building and a retaining wall approximately 16' from the building line. This area, within the 80' width limits of Bancroft Avenue, is about 4' below the average ground level, and is not presently traversable to vehicles.

Applicant is authorized to deviate from the requirements of Section 3.17 of General Order No. 26-D provided that other requirements of said General Order are complied with.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
