Beginning at the point where State Highway No. 118 intersects with State Highway No. 27; easteriy and northoasterly along State Highway No. 118 to State Highway No. 7; nowtherly along State Highway No. 7 to Rinaldi Stroot; oastoriy on Rinalds Streot and Workman Street; westerly and northerly along the boundary of the City of San Fernando and its prolongation to the boundary of the Angelos National Forest; oasterly and southerly along the boundary of the Angeles National Forest to U. S. Highway No. 395; southerly along U. S. Highway No. 395 to U. S. Highway No. 99; easterly along U. S. Highway No. 99 to and including the City of Rediands; southeasteriy along on imaginary line to the intersection of U. S. Highways Nos. 60 and 395; southerly on J. S. 7. Commodities whon transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
