O R D E R

The County of Stanislaus is authorized to construct Moffett Road at grade across a track of Tidewater Southern Railway Company near Turlock, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 75-40.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Tidewater Southern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three and one-half percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) or two Standard No. 1 signs equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
