BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of METROPOLITAN COACH LINES, a corporation, for an in lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity to consolidate all its passenger stage operative rights.

Application No. 36930

OPINION

Metropolitan Coach Lines, in the above-entitled application, requests the Commission to grant to it a new passenger stage certificate of public convenience and necessity which will include therein all of its present passenger stage operative rights in their entirety which are presently set forth in approximately 45 decisions of the Commission. Applicant also requests that there be included in the same order a new description of all the authorizations to operate motor vehicles in excess of ninety-six inches but not exceeding one hundred and four inches in width, and in excess of thirty-five feet but not exceeding forty feet in length. Such equipment is generally referred to as "oversize buses". The new certificate and the new oversize bus equipment authority in each case would supersede all of such operative rights and authorities issued by the Commission and presently held by applicant which would be revoked.

Applicant does not propose any change, extension or enlargement of its present operative rights or oversize bus authorities nor does it propose any changes of service, tariffs, rules or regulations applicable to its present operations. The applicant points out that it is authorized to transport shipments

of express not exceeding 100 pounds in weight and baggage as well as passengers on some of the routes over which it operates. It is also authorized to turn its motor vehicles at the termini of routes or at points intermediate thereto in either direction at intersections of streets. Under its present authority applicant may operate its passenger stage service as a unified system. It desires to retain all these rights.

Generally speaking, applicant conducts its operations in the area encompassed by Los Angeles, Castellammare, San Fernando, Pasadena, San Bernardino, Riverside, Corona, Santa Ana, Seal Beach, Santa Monica and the intervening points.

As justification for the authority sought applicant points out that the Commission in 1946 granted a new certificate to applicant's predecessor for the purpose of clarifying the latter's operative rights at that time. Again in 1951 a new certificate was granted to applicant's predecessor for the purpose of combining in one decision its operative authorities together with the many changes which had been made in the intervening period.

Applicant states that it again becomes necessary to bring all the operative authorities into one decision as many of the present certificates held by it were issued in the name of its predecessor which results in considerable confusion. Applicant acquired the operative rights of its predecessor in October, 1953. Since that time, applicant has received authority to make a number of changes in routes.

Applicant requests in the interest of simplified maintenance that the Commission issue to it a new "in lieu certificate" in a "loose-leaf form" covering all of its present passenger stage operations and in the form proposed in its Exhibit "B" attached to

the application.

The Commission does not issue so-called "in lieu certificates". Operative rights may be restated in new certificates which are issued in replacement of previously granted certificates. Neither does the Commission issue certificates in a "loose-leaf form". However, it does render decisions granting certificates of public convenience and necessity with the specifications of the operation set forth in an appendix attached which may be adapted to a loose-leaf system.

After full consideration of applicant's request the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that applicant be granted a new certificate authorizing service as a passenger stage corporation to, from and between the points and over the routes as more specifically set forth in paragraph (1) of the following order. The new certificate will be issued in an appendix form which is designed so that it can and may be adapted to a loose-leaf system. Under such plan the currently effective operative authority of the applicant can be kept current by the issuance of substitute sheets reflecting corrections, changes, extensions or other modifications of the operative authority involved.

Applicant states that its request, if granted, in no way would change its competitive position with any other carrier.

Notwithstanding, copies of the application have been served on other carriers operating in the area, as well as other parties who might be interested. No objection thereto has been made. A public hearing appears to be unnecessary and the application will be granted as set forth in the following order.

After full consideration of applicant's request and the

evidence of record it is further found that the public interest requires a restatement of the authority presently held by applicant for the operation of passenger stage equipment in excess of thirty-five feet but not more than forty feet in length, and in excess of ninety-six inches but not exceeding one hundred and four inches in width as more particularly set forth in paragraph (2) of the order herein.

ORDER

An application therefor having been filed and duly considered by the Commission and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Metropolitan Coach Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, their baggage, and express between the termini and all points intermediate thereto and over the routes as described and specified in Appendix A which is attached hereto and, by this reference, made a part hereof subject to the provisions, restrictions, limitations and specifications contained therein. Service under this certificate shall be conducted as a single consolidated and unified operation.
- (2) Applicant is hereby authorized to operate passenger stage equipment in excess of thirty-five feet but not more than forty feet in length, and in excess of ninety-six inches but not exceeding one hundred and four inches in width between the points and over the

(3) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in paragraph (1) of this order is not in addition to nor an enlargement of applicant's existing operative rights or authorities, as otherwise granted, but supersedes all presently existing certificates of public convenience and necessity or other passenger stage operative rights held by applicant, as well as all authorities heretofore granted to applicant for the operation of passenger stage equipment of excess length or width all as set forth in the following decisions of the Commission which are hereby revoked.

- (4) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
 - a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty days after the offective date hereof.

- b. Applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79, 80 and 98 by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tarifis and timetables satisfactory to the Commission within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.
- c. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall file with the Commission three sets of maps drawn to an indicated scale upon sheets of paper 8½ x 11 inches in size. Upon each set of maps there shall be delineated in a distinctive manner all routes, by classes, and principal points which applicant is authorized to serve. Each sheet of each set of maps in addition to the foregoing shall also show the name of applicant, a designation of the route group to which it relates, proper orientation and other information essential to a clear understanding of the map.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

- 3. No passengers shall be transported whose origin and destination are both south of the intersection of Alondra Boulevard and Pioneer Boulevard.
- 14. The transportation service herein authorized shall be rendered only when horse-racing is conducted at Los Alamitos Race Track.

From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, or, as an alternate, from Los Angeles Street Terminal (Los Angeles), via Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, Whittier Boulevard, Atlantic Boulevard, Telegraph Road, Lakewood Boulevard, Florence Avenue, Downey Avenue (Downey), Firestone Boulevard (Santa Ana Freeway), Whitaker Avenue (Buena Park), Magnolia Avenue, Commonwealth Avenue (Fullerton), Spadra Road, Los Angeles Street (Anaheim), U. No single shipment of express that weighs in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be accepted for transportation, and all express shall be transported on passenger-carrying vehicles only, provided that this condition shall be further subject to any special limitations hereinbefore specifically stated.

The company is relieved from the minimum rate provisions of Decision No. 31606, in Case No. 4246, as amended.

The company is authorized to transport express matter and baggage within limits as defined in applicable tariffs over routes numbered 56, 58, 59, 60, 62, 63, and 64, respectively.

B. OFF ROUTE SERVICE TO SCHOOLS

The company is authorized to divert from its authorized routes, either on its regular schedules or on special
schedules, for the purpose of transporting bona fide pupils
attending institutions of learning between their homes and
such institutions of learning, provided that such divergence

and schedules therefor are filed in the same manner as other time schedules, and, if special rates are provided, schedules thereof also are filed.

C. TURNING MOTOR COACHES

The company is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini or intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, or in accord with local traffic regulations.

D. DIRECTION OF ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS

When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction or one direction, unless otherwise indicated.

E. RELOCATED HIGHWAYS

For the general operation of its system on reconstruction or relocation of highways not affecting intermediate points, the company may reroute over such reconstructed or relocated highways, provided that the company shall first advise the Commission, in writing, of said highway and route change, said notice to be accompanied by a sketch or map showing the highways involved.

SECTION 3 - MOTOR COACHES OF EXCESS LENGTH AND WIDTH
