Application of the CITY OF SANTA CLARA to construct a public highway and strip across the Southern Pacific Railroad Company (Oakland-San Jose Right of Way Area) at Station 2173 + 80 at Grade. )

O R D E R

The City of Santa Clara is authorized to construct a public road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. L-42.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach shall be substantially as indicated in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
