## OPINION

M and M Transfer Company, a corporation, is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities, with certain exceptions, between:

- All points in Los Angeles Territory as that territory is defined in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.
- 2. All points on and within ten miles laterally of the following routes:
  - a. U. S. Highway 66 between Los Angeles Territory and San Bernardino.
  - b. U. S. Highway 70-99 between Los Angeles Territory and Redlands.
  - c. U. S. Highway 60 between Los Angeles Territory and Riverside.
  - d. U. S. Highways 101 and 101 Bypass between Los Angeles Territory and Santa Ana.
  - e. State Highway 39 between Fullerton and its junction with U.S. 101 Alternate.
- 3. All points on and ten miles laterally of each of said routes and points on or ten miles laterally of each of the other routes.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

- 2. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the follow-
  - Within thirty days after the effective date acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public applicant is placed upon notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 99. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
  - Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than ten days! notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
