FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 52738, dated March 13, 1956, the Commission authorized Evergreen Water Company, Inc., to issue a note in the face amount of not exceeding \$7,252.49 and to execute a deed of trust to secure its payment.

Applicant reports that the proposed lender of the \$7,252.49 has asked for security in the form of a chattel mortgage on certain pumping facilities in addition to the deed of trust on the real property. It has filed a copy of the proposed form of mortgage and it has requested the Commission to make a supplemental order authorizing its execution.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion a public hearing is not necessary and that applicant's request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Evergreen Water Company, Inc., may execute a chattel mortgage in, or substantially in, the same

form as that filed with its first supplemental application in this proceeding.

This order will become effective upon the date hereof.
