ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Petition for Modification No. 70, in this proceeding, California Trucking Associations, Inc., requested that "the scope of existing investigations be broadened to include an investigation of the need and desirability of revision of the minimum rate order governing the transportation of lumber generally within the State of California", and that "the Commission staff be instructed to make such studies of the situation which are necessary to formulate proper revisions".


Such staff studies are in progress. By separate order issued today, the Commission has ordered that hearings be held relative to rates for the transportation of lumber between all points in California. That order grants the relief sought in the Association's petition. The petition will, accordingly, be dismissed.


Therefore, good cause appearing,




This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.


