ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct

Baldwin Avenue at grade across the Southern Pacific Company's El Paso

Route near the City of El Monte, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No.

B-493.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also

maintenence cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern

Pacific Company shall beer maintenance cost between such lines. Width

of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not

greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior

to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard

No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. 75-B).

Upon the opening of Crossing No. B-493.6, Shirley Avenue (Crossing No. B-493.7) shall be abandoned and closed at the entire expense of applicant.

Within thirty days after completion pursuent to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless

time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
