OPINION

Security Truck Line is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and certificates of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to extend its service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities, with certain exceptions, so as to serve between all points in California north of the northern boundaries of Santa Barbara, Ventura and Los Angeles Counties and the western and northern boundaries of San Bernardino County.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order. It appears that applicant possesses the experience, equipment, personnel and financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized herein. Such order will restate applicant's highway common carrier operative rights. A public hearing is not necessary.

in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.
- (3) That all of applicant's operative rights, except those granted by Decision No. 44356, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31166, are cancelled simultaneously with the making of the filings pursuant to and as required by the provisions of paragraph (2) hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.

Security Truck Line, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision, is authorized to transport general commodities between (1) San Francisco and Hollister and intermediate points via U.S.

Highway 101 and 101 By Pass, State Highway 156 and on unnumbered road between Gilroy and Hollister and (2) San Martin and Coyote Dam via San Martin Avenue to Foothill Boulevard, thence along Foothill Boulevard.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- 1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- 2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
- 3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
- 5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.

- 6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- 7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
