O P I N I O N

Pacific Motor Trucking Company requests authority to transport bulk cement in special hopper-body equipment in lots of not less than 40,000 pounds, from Friant to the site of the Wishon Dam.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the dam, which is presently under construction, is situated approximately sixty-seven miles southeast of Friant; that the cost of the dam will be in excess of \$13,000,000; and that it will involve the use of approximately 24,440 tons of cement, the first of which will be required on or about May 1, 1956.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. Because of the immediate need for the service the effective date of the order will be the date hereof.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission having been informed in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing the

establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of bulk cement, in special hopper-body equipment in lots of not less than 40,000 pounds, from Friant to the site of the Wishon Dam, over any and all available roads and highways.

(2) That, in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the public, applicant shall establish the service authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective appropriate tariffs.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
