O R D E R

The application of Southern Pacific Company and The California, Arizona and Santa Fe Railway Company (The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company), filed on March 17, 1956, requests authority for each railroad to convey to the other, for a consideration, certain properties described therein, and located in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County. The Commission being fully informed in the premises and it appearing that such transactions are not contrary to public interest, therefore;

IT IS ORDERED that the authority requested by the applicants is hereby granted, permitting Southern Pacific Company to convey an undivided one-half interest in the property described in "Exhibit A" of the application to The California, Arizona and Santa Fe Railway Company, and permitting The California, Arizona and Santa Fe Railway Company to convey an undivided one-half interest in the property described in "Exhibit B" of the application to Southern Pacific Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authorization shall be void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, and that the effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
