O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a second main track at grade across 56th Avenue at Thermal, County of Riverside, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-617.9. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement between the two parties dated February 6, 1956. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a minimum width of 38 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates for the main and passing tracks and two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material for the northerly side track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that added track facility will be needed for perishable fruit movement about June 1, 1956. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
