In the matter of the application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct, operate, and maintain a spur track at grade across Dominguez Street in the County of Los Angeles.

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Dominguez Street, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6M-15.62-C (erroneously referred to as Crossing No. 6M-16.02-C in the application). Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
