O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to construct a main line track at grade across Arboga Road near Alicia, Yuba County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8-130.0. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be

revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that construction of this track is urgently needed to restore rail service to the Marysville area and has requested early authorization.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
