O R D E R

The City of Manteca is authorized to construct Center Street at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company and Tidewater Southern Railway Company in the City of Manteca, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. B-96.5 and 75B-4.6, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company and Tidewater Southern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than sixty feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at Crossing No. B-96.5 shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Protection at Crossing No. 75B-4.6 shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or
safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty
days after the date hereof.
