

In the circumstances, it appears that the proposed adjustment in the minimum rates is reasonable and should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 1, 1956, Sixth Revised Page 5 Cancels Fifth Revised Page 5 and Twelfth Revised Page 29 Cancels Eleventh Revised Page 29, which pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


(2) That tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effectiveness of the tariff changes herein involved.


(3) That in all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
