## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Investigation into the rates, rules, regulations, charges, allowances and practices of all common carriers, highway carriers and city carriers relating to the transportation of property in Los Angeles and Orange Counties (transportation for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5).

## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of property in the Los Angeles Drayage Area are set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. Item No. 340-K of the tariff provides commodity rates for various commodities including specifically named iron and steel articles.

By this petition, W. A. Woods, a radial highway common carrier and a city carrier, seeks the inclusion of pig iron under the heading: "Iron and Steel Articles, viz:" in Item No. 340-K. Petitioner states that the rates may apply to pig iron by interpretation of Item No. 340-K which specifically names iron billets and iron ingots; that pig iron is normally transported in dump trucks, loaded by mechanical devices and unloaded by dumping; and that pig iron has as favorable transportation characteristics as and lesser value than many of the articles for which rates are now provided in that item. He also states that the sought rates would be just and reasonable minimum rates for the transportation of pig iron.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection to its being granted has been received.

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In the circumstances, it appears that the proposed adjustment in the minimum rates is reasonable and should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No: 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 1, 1956, Sixth Revised Page 5 Cancels Fifth Revised Page 5 and Twelfth Revised Page 29 Cancels Eleventh Revised Page 29, which pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

(2) That tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effectiveness of the tariff changes herein involved.

(3) That in all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
