Vehicular traffic on State Route 68 (U.S. 101) shall DAbe protected from rail movements across Crossing No. AD-45.82-C by being flagged by a member of the train crew or other competent

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employee of the railroad company acting as flagman. The type of protection, two No.lA crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), is authorized for a period of three years from the date of this order. If after the expiration of the three-year period the crossing is still in existence the Commission will reopen the application, determine the protection needed and allocate the cost thereof.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with agreements to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copies of said agreements, together with plans of said crossings approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
