O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Route 77 (formerly Valley Boulevard) at grade across the San Bernardino Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company, in the City of El Monte, County of Los Angeles, at the location and in the manner described in Exhibit "A" as amended and as shown on Exhibit "B" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-13.31. The crossing shall consist of two 30-foot traffic lanes divided by a variable-width median, substantially as shown on Exhibit "B". Grades of approach shall be not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant is further authorized to alter Valley Boulevard (Crossing No. 6T-13.26) and relocate one Standard No. 8 flashing light signal in the manner described in Exhibit "A" as amended and as shown on Exhibit "C" attached to the application.

Construction and maintenance expense of Crossing No. 6T-13.31 and alteration of Crossing No. 6T-13.26 shall be borne in accordance with agreements to be negotiated between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company, and a copy of the executed agreements, together with plans approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
