O P I N I O N

By this application authority is sought to make a slight route change in applicant's Route "12" line to provide service to a new shopping center in National City known as "South Bay Plaza" and situated along 10th Street two blocks south of the present route between Highland Avenue and "L" Avenue. A segment of the present route along 8th Street between Highland Avenue and "L" Avenue will be abandoned. This change will not materially inconvenience present patrons. No other change is proposed<sup>1/</sup> and present schedules and fares will not be affected. The matter is not controversial, and, as the new route appears to be in the public interest, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

<sup>1/</sup> The description of the proposed new route appearing in the application inadvertently omitted a portion of the present route along Harbison Avenue, 16th Street and Rachael Avenue. Applicant has filed a corrected route description.

O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

That the description of Route "12" appearing in paragraph (4) of the Order in Decision No. 50943, on Application No. 35896, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Route "12" -

Beginning at the intersection of 8th Street and National Avenue in National City, thence along 8th Street, Highland Avenue, 10th Street, "L" Avenue, 8th Street, Harbison Avenue, 16th Street, Rachael Avenue, Albemarle Avenue, Calle Serena, Alleghany Street, Munda Road, Oriskany Road, Ranger Road, Saipan Drive to its intersection with Munda Road.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
