O R D E R

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route IV-Son-1-C (U.S. 101) at separated grades over the track of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, near Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit "B") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-48.7-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order 26-D. During the period of construction applicant is authorized to deviate from the provisions of General Order No. 26-D to the extent of a temporary vertical clearance of 20' 0" above top of rail, and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to operate with such temporary impaired clearance provided it issue appropriate bulletins to train service employees advising them of the temporary impaired clearances and forbidding them to ride on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 5-48.8 about 500' northerly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
