OPINION

Shippers Express Company is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and certificates of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to extend its service as a highway common carrier so as to transport general commodities between points in northern, central and southern California.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the applicant be authorized to extend its highway common carrier service so as to include therein the transportation of general commodities between Santa Ana and San Diego. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

The Commission has considered the application and representations filed herein, Now Therefore

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That ordering paragraph (2)(d) of Decision No. 51286, dated April 5, 1955, in Application No. 34799, is amended to read:
 - "(d) Points and places on U. S. Highways Nos. 101 and 101 By-pass between Los Angeles and San Diego, including San Diego;"
- (2) That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the authority herein granted.
- (3) That within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
