## OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants seek authority to enlarge their pickup and delivery zone at Livermore and to apply the Livermore rates to the enlarged territory.

The application shows that the area proposed to be added to the present zone is contiguous to and a part of the community and that this area is situated within three miles of the corporate limits. It shows also that the applicants have been requested to provide the additional pickup and delivery service involved. Under the proposed arrangements, all similarly situated areas contiguous to Livermore where there is a demand for applicants' pickup and delivery service would be afforded service at the Livermore rates. Because of the relatively short distances involved, the resulting deviations from the established minimum rates would be slight.

Competing carriers have been notified of the filing of the application. No objection has been received.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought authority is justified.
