O P I N I O N

By the above application filed June 13, 1956, Vallejo Transit Lines, a co-partnership, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing passenger stage operations between downtown Vallejo and the Solano County Fairgrounds. This operation was previously performed by the City of Vallejo Bus Lines, the predecessor of the Vallejo Transit Lines. The proposed service will be over the same route previously operated and at the same fares charged by Vallejo Bus Lines. The requested service is to be furnished during the annual Solano County Fair from July 6 to 14, 1956, and at such other dates as special events warrant public transportation. No other public service is available to transport the citizens of Vallejo and contiguous areas to the Fairgrounds. The matter is not controversial, and, as the service appears to be in the public interest, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary. The order will be made effective on the date hereof to permit commencement when the Fair opens.

O R D E R

Application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed and finding that public convenience and necessity require that the request be granted without public hearing by amending Appendix A of Decision No. 52973 in Application No. 37959.

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Vallejo Citizens Transit Company, a California corporation, Kenneth D. Grayson, George A. Grinestaff, Carl Maine, Henry L. Cofer, Wenneth W. Fitzgerald, Herman Petrie and Theodore M. Peterson, co-partners, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers between the City of Vallejo and the Solano County Fairgrounds and all intermediate points thereto and over the route as described on Original Page 9 of Appendix A which is attached hereto.

(2) That Appendix A of Decision No. 52973 in Application No. 37959 is hereby amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 8 and Original Page 9 of Appendix A attached hereto.

(3) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public applicants shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

(4) That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
