O P I N I O N

Gibson Lines, a corporation, requests authority to suspend its passenger stage service to and from Beale Air Force Base, near Marysville, for one year. (1)

As justification therefor applicant asserts that for the past year it has provided service to and from Camp Beale expecting an increase in the personnel. Applicant is now informed that the United States Army has decided to "reduce Camp Beale to a stand-by basis" only. A maintenance force of about 100 men will be retained. The Commanding Officer has informed applicant in substance that the Base has no need for public transportation at this time, and has no objection to applicant's proposal to temporarily suspend the service.

After full consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity will be subserved by granting applicant's

(1) The operative right involved was created by Decision No. 35334 in Application No. 24439 and modified by Decision No. 36886 dated February 15, 1944, in Supplemental Application No. 24439 to read:

"(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Gibson Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined by section 24, Public Utilities Act, as an extension of, in addition to, and to be consolidated with the passenger stage service now conducted by said Gibson Lines, between Marysville, Ostrom, and Wheatland, respectively, on the one hand, and Marysville Army Cantonment, situated approximately ten miles east of Marysville, on the other hand, and intermediate points."

request. We see no need for a public hearing.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Gibson Lines is hereby authorized to suspend passenger stage operations to and from Beale Air Force Base (formerly Marysville Army Cantonment) as more particularly defined in the order of Decision No. 36886, until July 1, 1957.

(2) That applicant shall post an appropriate notice of suspension of operations, as herein authorized, at its Marysville and Sacramento stations and in all equipment serving Beale Air Force Base for a minimum of five days next preceding said suspension of operations.

(3) That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall file appropriate tariffs or supplemental tariffs and timetables in triplicate reflecting the authority herein granted which tariffs and timetables shall be satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
