ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Slauson Avenue at separated grades near the town of Los Nietos, County of Los Angeles, over the Puente Branch of the Southern Pacific Company to be identified as Crossing No. BKA-501.7-A, and over the main line of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-151.9-A, in the manner described in the application and at the location shown upon the map Exhibit "A" attached thereto. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroads shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction.

Applicant is authorized to temporarily deviate from the clearances prescribed by General Order No. 26-D as follows:

During the period of construction applicant is authorized to deviate to the extent of a horizontal side clearance of not less than 8'6" from center line of track at Pier No. 6 of the structure, and a temporary vertical clearance of 21'0" above top of rail at the north end of Pier No. 5 of the structure, and Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to operate with such

impaired clearances provided they issue appropriate bulletins to train service employees advising them of the temporary impaired clearance conditions and forbidding them to ride on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Upon completion of the grade separation structure, and its being opened to public travel, Rivera Road (Crossing No. BKA-501.7) shall be abandoned and removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
