BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMUISSION OF TEE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the state of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the abandonment of two oxisting crossings at grade, the construction of a pedestrian crossing at separated grades, the alteration of an existing crossing at separated grades and the construction of a new crossing at separated grades between the tracks of the Southern

Application No. 37855 Pacific Company's coast Route and State Route $V-S B-2,150,80-S B, P, Q, A, C$, In Santa Barbara County, sometimes referred to as "Junipero St. Ped. Ovorhead", "Ias Positas Overhead" and "La Cumbre Road Overhead"
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The Department of Pablic Works of the State of Califormia in comection with improvement of portions of state Route 2 (U. S. 101) botwoen Los OIfos Stroot in the City of Santa Barbara and El Sueno Road, within the county, a distance of approximately 3.45 miles , is authorizec to construct a pedestrian overkead, alter existing highway overhead, construct a new highway overhead, abandon two existing public crossings at grade and to temporarily deriate from provisions of General Order No. 26-D, at locations described in Exhibit "A" and as shown on Exhibits "B" to "E" inciusive, attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

1. Identifying crossing numbers and widths of the various crossings quthorized heroin shali be in accordance with the tabuiation attached as Appendix
2. The entire oxpense of construction and mantenance of the grade separations and removel of grade crossings authorized horein shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreomont to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of
the executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction.
3. Upon completion of La Cumbre Road Overhead, State Route 150 (Crossing No. E-366.7-A) and its being opened to public use, La Cumbre Road (Crossing No. E-366.8) and Modoc Road (Crossing No. E-367.65) shall bo abandoned and removed.
4. C Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D except as follows:

> During the period of construction of the grade separations applicant is authorized to deviate to the extent of a vertical clearance of $20^{\circ \prime \prime}$ above tops of rails at Crossings Nos. E-366.7-A, E-368.0-A and E-368. 3-AD. Southern pacific Company is authorsized to operate with such clearances provided that it issues appropriate operating bulletins to its train service employees advising them of the tempo racy impaired clearance conditions and forbidding them from riding on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structures.

> Within thirty days after completion or removal of each cross-

ing, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commassion in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercased within two Fears, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modefled if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the dato hereof.
