O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 66th Street and across Bay Street in the Town of Emeryville, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-7.82 and Crossing No. A-7.84-C, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two and one-half percent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
