ORDER

The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, filed on May 7, 1956, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Cressy during the past four years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Cressy, County of Merced; to remove all facilities at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not

cxcreised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
