ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 52141 in this proceeding, a certificate was granted to Melvin H. Uhrich authorizing him to establish a passenger stage service between the Douglas Aircraft Company plant, on the one hand, and Fullerton and Anaheim, on the other hand.

Under date of April 12, 1956, Uhrich wrote the Commission that he had discontinued the authorized operation on March 1, 1956, because of insufficient revenues, that he allowed his insurance protection to lapse, that he has no intention of resuming the operation, and has no objection to the revocation of the certificate granted by Decision No. 52141.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 52141 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Melvin H. Uhrich are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
