ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 48623 the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Irwin M. MacLeod and Arthur R. Mann authorizing a passenger stage service between Sonoma and Glen Ellen and intermediate points.

The Commission's section of Permits and Fees reports that as of April 27, 1956, all public liability insurance and property damage insurance covering said Irwin M. MacLeod and Arthur R. Mann was canceled, that said MacLeod on May 4, 1956, telephoned that as of March 30, 1956, all service conducted pursuant to said Decision No. 48623 was discontinued and the operative right therefor was abandoned, that there is no intention of resuming operations thereunder and that said operative right be canceled.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative right created by Decision No. 48623 is hereby revoked and all effective

tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Irwin M. MacLeod and Arthur R. Mann are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
