ORDER OF REVOCATION

George J. Webb, formerly doing business as Piano Moving Service, by Decision No. 51680, dated July 12, 1955, in Application No. 36061 was granted a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of musical instruments, television receivers and radios between San Francisco and four East Bay cities. He also held a city carrier permit and certain highway carrier permits.

The transportation division reports that on December 1, 1955, the permits referred to were transferred from said George J. Webb to William H. Miller, that on November 11, 1955, all of the automotive equipment and business of said Webb were also transferred to William H. Miller and that all public liability and property damage insurance covering George J. Webb was canceled by appropriate notice filed with the Commission on December 16, 1955.

In view of the foregoing circumstances, the Commission finds that said George J. Webb has discontinued and abandoned the highway common carrier operations above-described without first having appropriate authority therefor.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 51680, dated July 12, 1955,

in Application No. 36061 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of George J. Webb are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon George J. Webb in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon George J. Webb unless said George J. Webb before such effective date shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
