Security Truck Line, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between (1) San Francisco and Hollister and intermediate points via U. S. Highway 101 and 101 Bypass, State Highway 156 and on unnumbered road between Gilroy and Hollister and (2) San Martin and Coyote Dam via San Martin Avenue to Foothill Boulevard, thence along Foothill Boulevard.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.

6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.

The restrictions immediately set forth above in 1. through 7. shall apply only to local service rendered between San Francisco and Coyote and points intermediate thereto.
