ORDER OF REVOCATION

Paul Ludolph Company, a corporation, by Decision No. 29768, dated May 17, 1937, was authorized to acquire from Paul Ludolph, an individual, a highway common carrier certificate created by Decision No. 28293, dated October 21, 1935, in Application No. 20120. That certificate authorized the transportation of milk and other dairy products between San Francisco, San Jose, Los Gatos and intermediate points.

It now appears that all public liability and property damage insurance covering the corporation was canceled on November 25, 1955; that the highway contract carrier permit issued to the corporation was canceled on December 28, 1955, and that a letter addressed to the Commission by the secretary and attorney for the corporation dated May 17, 1956, states that the corporation in the year 1955 discontinued and abandoned all trucking operations and was dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the Corporation Code.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative right hereinabove referred to is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of PAUL LUDOLPH COMPANY are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
