ORDER OF REVOCATION

It appearing by Decision No. 34545 in Application No. 23835 that A. S. Eiri was authorized to conduct highway common carrier operations for the transportation of fish and shrimp from San Pedro to certain points extending from Fresno to Sacramento, both inclusive;

It further appearing by Decision No. 36049, dated December 22, 1942, in Application No. 25375, said Eiri was authorized to suspend that operation until further order of the Commission;

It further appearing by Decision No. 52123, dated October 25, 1955, that the Commission modified the terms of the order of said Decision No. 36049 so as to terminate as of March 31, 1956, the authority theretofore granted to said Eiri to suspend said operations.

It now appearing that numerous inquiries over a long period of time have been directed to said Eiri with respect to the re-establishment of services to which he has consistently replied that he lacks the financial and physical resources to restore the operations;

Therefore, it is found that A. S. Eiri has failed to resume the above-described operations within the time specified, and that he has in fact abandoned said operations without obtaining appropriate authority therefor.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to A. S. Eiri by Decision No. 34545, dated August 26, 1941, in Application No. 23835 is hereby revoked and all tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of A. S. Eiri, effective or suspended, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy hereof to be served upon A. S. Eiri in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date hereof shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon A. S. Eiri, unless said A. S. Eiri before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
