Application of AMERVALE SERVICE CORPORATION, a corporation, to acquire and operate a water system, for order approving rates, and for authority to issue stock in exchange for cash and the said water system.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 51695, dated July 18, 1955, the Commission granted to Amervale Service Corporation a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system near Quincy and, at the same time, authorized the company to issue 625½ shares of stock. The order of the Commission provided that the authorization would expire on July 18, 1956. By an amendment the time for issuing stock was extended to August 1, 1956.

It appears that the development of the system has not been completed and, accordingly, the company has requested the Commission to extend the time limits now specified.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion that it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Amervale Service Corporation may complete the construction and operation of the public utility water system and may issue the

625½ shares of stock heretofore authorized by Decision No. 51695, dated July 18, 1955, as amended, be, and it hereby is extended to February 1, 1957.

This supplemental order will become effective on the date hereof.
