FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 52861, dated April 10, 1956, the Commission granted Avalon Public Service Company certificates of public convenience and necessity. Ordering Paragraph 7 directed the company to submit to the Commission, within 60 days after the effective date of the order, copies of the journal entries which it used to set up its fixed capital and depreciation reserve accounts.

The company reports that it has not completed negotiations with the City of Avalon to settle ownership of certain property and hence has not set up the book accounts. The time for filing the entries has expired and the company has requested an extension.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Avalon Public Service Company shall file the copies of the journal entries

required by Ordering Paragraph 7 of the order in Decision No. 52861, dated April 10, 1956, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including September 30, 1956.

This first supplemental order is effective on the date hereof.
