ORDER VACATING ORDER SETTING HEARING

By Petition No. 18, filed January 7, 1956, in this proceeding, William Gilmore and Kenneth Page, and Elmer Ahl, their agent, requested authority to establish certain rates for the transportation of crude oil in the vicinity of Huntington Beach. It appearing that granting of the petition in the respects sought might also entail corresponding revisions in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6, an order setting hearing was entered in Case No. 5436 on May 8, 1956, in order that along with the receipt of evidence in Petition No. 18, evidence might be received to determine to what extent, if at all, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6 should also be revised.

Petitioners have since stated that they do not wish to proceed in the prosecution of their request. By separate order issued today Petition No. 18 was therefore dismissed. In the circumstances it appears that the phase of this proceeding initiated by the order setting hearing should likewise be terminated.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-described order setting hearing, dated May 8, 1956, in Case No. 5436, be and it hereby is vacated.
