Application of the State of

 Route XI-Imp-12-A and the re-
 located main line track of the
 San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway
 Company in Imperial County, some-
 times referred to as "Coyote Wells
 Underpass".

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Route XI-Imp-12-A (U.S. 80) at separated grades under the main line track of San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company in Imperial County, in the manner described in Exhibit "A" and at the location as shown on Exhibit "B" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36-119.1-B.

Applicant and San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company are also authorized to relocate a portion of the main line track to the site of the new separation structure substantially as shown on Exhibit "B" and, upon completion thereof, to abandon and remove that portion of the present trackage which will no longer be operated.

Upon completion of Crossing No. 36-119.1-B and its being opened to public use, Crossing No. 36-119.0-B shall be abandoned and removed.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
