O R D E R

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route V-SLO-2-PsRs (U.S. 101) at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo County, at the locations shown on Exhibits A to E inclusive attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-214.1-A known as North Paso Robles Overhead and Crossing No. E-217.0-A, known as South Paso Robles Overhead. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless

time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
