FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 52579, dated February 7, 1956, the Commission authorized Ducor Telephone Company to execute a conditional sales contract with Stromberg-Carlson, a division of General Dynamics Corporation, providing for payment of \$2,408.90 for the purchase of additional telephone facilities. The time within which such contract might be executed expired on June 30, 1956.

The company reports that Virgil A. Roome, its president and executive officer, has been outside of the State of California on business matters and was unable to execute the contract prior to June 30, 1956. It now requests that it be permitted to execute such contract on or before August 30, 1956.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion that it should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The time within which Ducor Telephone Company may execute the conditional sales contract authorized by Decision No. 52579, dated February 7, 1956, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including August 30, 1956.

2. The authority herein granted will become effective on the date hereof.
