BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, and its Lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, for an order authorizing the maintenance and operation of existing industry spur tracks and the construction of additional spur tracks over and across Noakes Street, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

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Union Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct five spur tracks at grade across Noakes Street in Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3-4.19-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance exponse. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so adviso the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

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with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
