- B. San Francisco, on the one hand, and points located on U. S. Highway 99 between Manteca and Bakersfield, both inclusive, on the other hand, including the off-route points of Riverbank, Escalon and Oakdale.
- C. San Francisco, on the one hand, and points located on State Highway 33 between Patterson and Maricopa, both inclusive, on the other hand, including the point of Los Banos.
- D. San Francisco, on the one hand, and points located laterally within 15 miles of U. S. Highway 99 between Fresno and Delano, both inclusive, on the other hand.
- E. Fresno, on the one hand, and points located on U. S. Highway 99 between Manteca and Bakersfield, both inclusive, on the other hand, including the off-route points of Riverbank, Oakdale, Escalon, Biola and Kerman.
- F. Fresno, on the one hand, and points located on State Highway 33 between Patterson and Maricopa, both inclusive, on the other hand, including the point of Los Banos.

Such operating authorities do not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shall not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities hereinabove set forth in paragraphs A, B, C, D, E, and F.
