O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Cerritos Avenue in the City of Anaheim, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BM-512.75-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and to provide for a minimum street width of 24 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material. No cars shall be spotted on the drill track on either side of Cerritos Avenue within a distance of 200 feet from the edge of the pavement, measured at right angles.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
